Advocate Good Samaritan Hospital is a 313-bed, non-teaching hospital in Downers Grove, IL. It is the only Level I Trauma Center in DuPage County. The organization includes a Level III NICU and specializes in heart, spine and cancer care. Advocate Good Samaritan is accredited in Metabolic and Bariatric Surgery and certified as a DNV Primary Stroke Center. The hospital has been recognized for Nursing Excellence by the American Nurses Credentialing Center Magnet Recognition Program® since 2009.
